BROADCAST

Our Livestream capabilities are extremely flexible and can be adjusted to fit clients' needs. Livestream events can be ticketed, or free to watch by anyone. BPAC can broadcast livestream events from our website, or clients can embed the stream on their own site. Livestream events can be seen by a small list of viewers, or broadcast for free to thousands of people.
